- Minimum of 5' tall and max of 7' tall and cannot hang past the curb
- Must be maintained by exhibitor and removed between Nov. 1st to Nov. 3rd.
- All exhibitors are responsible to hang their own character with a sturdy rope or wire
- If the character is damaged beyond repair, you can either replace it or take it down. You can add to your character and enhance it, but you cannot remove it unless it is destroyed. You must contact us in advance of removal.
- Business Participation: the Business Name can be on a T-Shirt or a hat, a card no larger than 5x7 and must be attached to the scarecrow. Businesses win a 1st, 2nd & 3rd prize "certificate"
- No lewd, political or offensive characters and all characters must be attached to the pole securely and withstand the elements.
